The Art Manager is the main contact for the Art Department and the final arbiter of quality control. The Art Manager is also responsible for supervising all art shop staff, delegating tasks, and allocating staff resources to projects throughout the project lifecycle.

The successful Art Manager at Pacific Studio will:

- Supervise the art shop, with accountability for all Art Shop staff; ensure Art Shop is properly staffed to meet the project needs of Pacific Studio, considering staffing needs for the foreseeable future.
- Maintain quality control, exercising the authority to reject products for shipment, if necessary, to protect Pacific Studio's business interest.
- Ensure safety and cleanliness within department; oversee all safety efforts/initiatives within the Art Shop.
- Champion efficiency and process improvement initiatives to ensure maximum effort to meet time and budget deadlines. Constantly keep an eye open for efficiencies.
- Coordinate with Production Director and Project Managers to ensure that projects remain on schedule and to ensure that project schedules are met.
- Consult with Engineering Director and Project Managers on art/finishing techniques; consult on behalf of Art Shop production when appropriate.
- Keep the Production Director and Project Managers fully informed on the progress of assigned work in relation to overall project progress.
- Establish cooperative relationships with vendors, subcontractors, and clients.
- Represent Pacific Studio during client meetings and installations when needed.
- Make department purchases following established Pacific Studio budget protocol and maintaining the yearly budget for consumables and capital expenditures.
- Monitor time and materials for each job.

Minimum candidate requirements:

- Knowledge at Master-level in both 2D and 3D representational art. Must be skilled artist in at least one medium routinely utilized at Pacific Studio.
- Excellent organizational abilities.
- Broad-based practical knowledge of a variety of processes, materials, and techniques for sculpture, mold building, casting, mural painting, faux finishing, fine finishing, and industrial paint application.
- Minimum of two years management experience.
- Ability to read and comprehend construction drawings.
- Ability to travel out of town, state, and country for extended installations.
- Ability to work beyond normally scheduled hours to include nights, weekends, and holidays.
